

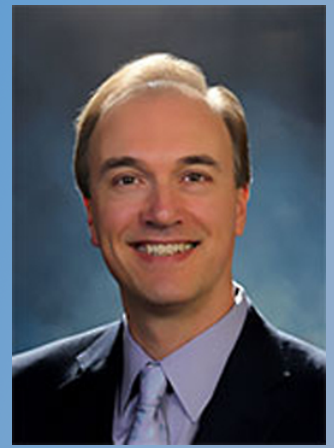
WILLIAM HINES
